Sergio and Linda Mijangos serve at the Central American Theological Seminary (CATS) in Guatemala City. Linda grew up at Cascades, and Sergio and Linda were married here. Also, Cascades is the Mijangos' sending church.

Over the years, Sergio and Linda have been involved in different positions at the seminary. Linda has served as coordinator of the scholarships program and has worked in the mailing office. She is currently taking care of their two boys, Derek (11-years-old) and Christian (8-years-old).
