People often ask the question, "What does a missionary mobilizer do?" A major part of what we do is sow spiritual seeds into the lives of others.

"And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart." Galatians 6:9

I usually start with a person by asking the question, "What is God doing in your life?" Then I ask, "How can I help you take the next step in God's kingdom purpose?" This gives me practical action steps in helping move a person into ministry. I pray for specific needs mentioned during our conversation and encourage them to continue in their walk of faith. These conversations happen on campuses, at mission conferences, and most often over the phone as I follow-up contacts. For every 100 students I talk with, about 2% join PIONEERS. It's my goal to connect relationally with students and help them take one step closer to Christ, no matter what organization they choose to serve with. In the long run, some people partner with PIONEERS and we help them plant churches in unreached people groups.

Sharla and I thank you for sowing into our lives. We were young college kids in the early 1990s with a vision for the unreached. After serving in a tribe in Papua New Guinea, God gives us the privilege of multiplying church planters to the nations. Your prayers, support, and relational commitment to us provides a platform for us to focus on the nations. Together we are sending new workers to the unreached, unengaged peoples of the earth. Together we experience God's blessing as we build into people's lives. We appreciate your partnership in the multiplication of the gospel.
